

Notifying the Patient of their Appointment

Thank you so very much for the opportunity to see for ophthalmic evaluation is a very nice 63-year-old gentleman seen on March 5 with a systemic history significant for insulin dependent diabetes and hypertension. At the time of his examination, Mr. has a best corrected visual acuity measuring 20/60 in the right eye and 20/150 in the left eye due, in part, to nuclear sclerotic and cortical cataracts, but also as the result of background diabetic retinopathy with dot and blot hemorrhaging.

Ultimately, Mr. I cataracts will need to be removed, but I want to make sure that the retina is stable first, so we are proceeding with further investigation to determine whether laser or anti-VEGF treatment would be in his best interest.
